As a **senior consultant**, he is responsible for realizing the integration of development support tools. These templates help to ensure a uniform structure among different projects, so that many artifacts (mainly the standard documentation artifacts like: SDD, SRS, SSS, SRD, SAD, STD, VDD etc.) may be generated in a uniform fashion and almost automatically. Specifically he developed an expertise in the integration of IBM/ Rational's tools (RSA, Rose, ClearQuest, RequisitePro, XDE for VS.NET & SoDA), Core and Doors, just to name a few.

He lectures on specific topics (e.g. SW Architecture overview – for different audiences, design patterns, UML related subjects and more). These are planned and customized according to customer's needs with his active cooperation.

As **trainer** at ACTL he developed course materials and exercises for lectures in UML, OOA/D & Software engineering. He also used his didactic skills while training participants in those topics. He passed the UML official certification of the OMG.
